

INETTT at a glance

- > Strategic, global network of non-profit independent think tanks working to scale and speed up sustainable energy transitions.
- > A trusted platform for stakeholder exchange and robust data-based policy analysis and recommendations.
- ➤ Launched in 2018, coordinated and hosted by Agora Energiewende in Berlin; Terms of Reference adopted in 2020.
- ➤ Cooperation network of currently 25 think tanks in 18 countries on research, exchange and capacity building.
- Governance Structure and Strategic Framework finalised in 2024.

Promoting understanding of energy transition challenges

and effective ways of addressing them across diverse countries and communities through joint research and discussion at the national, regional and global levels. 4

Engaging policymakers and stakeholders

Meeting and discussing energy transition with policymakers, civil society and other stakeholders, highlighting the need for diverse perspectives on global challenges.

Facilitating access to financial support

for dedicated project work for member think tanks and energy transition research, thereby helping build sustainable bottom-up capacity in developing countries for credible transition-related studies.
















